
CROSSFLIGHT Privacy Statement

CROSSFLIGHT Limited is a company registered in the United Kingdom with registered number 2111027 (hereinafter referred to as "CROSSFLIGHT").

This Privacy Statement is designed to tell you about CROSSFLIGHT's practices regarding collection, use, disclosure and storage of Personal Information (as defined below) that you may provide to us either directly or via CROSSFLIGHT's website. Please read this entire Privacy Policy before using or submitting information to CROSSFLIGHT.

Collection of Personal Information and purpose thereof:

CROSSFLIGHT collects and stores information about every package it handles in order to enable efficient provision of package delivery services demanded by its customers. CROSSFLIGHT uses information about its customers, their packages, and their shipping activity to provide or enhance the services it makes available to its customers, communicate with its customers about additional services they may find of value, satisfy our legitimate business interests (including performing trend analysis and market studies), set prices, establish credit, accomplish the billing function, and comply with government regulations.

As we collect and use information about our customers, we may contract with vendors to assist us in processing that information for those purposes listed in the previous paragraph. These vendors are required to maintain the confidentiality of the information and are restricted from using the information for any other purpose. In addition, as we continue to develop its business, we may buy or sell subsidiaries or business units. As part of these transactions, customer information of the subsidiaries or business units may be one of the transferred assets.

Examples of customer information that we collect include names, addresses, e-mail addresses and telephone numbers. Some of the information collected by CROSSFLIGHT is data which relates to an identifiable person ("Personal Information").

It is our policy to take all necessary steps to ensure that all your Personal Information held by us is processed fairly and lawfully. We will take all reasonable and necessary steps to implement and maintain this Privacy Policy. All our employees and data processors that have access to Personal Information are obliged to respect the confidentiality of your Personal Information.

Any Personal Information which we collect will be used solely for the purposes of providing our services and keeping our customers informed of our services and jobs specific to them.

Transfer of Personal Information

Your Personal Information may be transferred to countries outside the European Economic Area in order to perform our services. In using our services you consent to such a transfer. In addition, if you put your Personal Information on any publicly available parts of the website, this may be accessed by persons in countries outside the European Economic Area, which may not have data protection laws as comprehensive as those that exist in the European Economic Area.

We will monitor on an ongoing basis compliance with the provisions of the applicable local legislation and regulations by third party processors, such as suppliers and contractors, of Personal Information held by us.

Access and correction

You can find out which of your Personal Information is held by CROSSFLIGHT by contacting CROSSFLIGHT at its head office. We will acknowledge your request within 4 weeks. Should we be prevented from disclosing your personal information we will give reasons for any such refusal.

To keep your Personal Information accurate, current, and complete, please contact us as about any incorrect information. We will update or correct Personal Information in our possession.

CROSSFLIGHT websites

The following paragraphs describe our commitment to the protection of Personal Information as it applies to the CROSSFLIGHT websites.

Collection of Personal Information on CROSSFLIGHT websites

Users can visit most areas of our website without revealing who they are or without providing any information about themselves. However, some of our interactive services require that users identify themselves in order to enable the interactive function. For this purpose CROSSFLIGHT may ask users to provide Personal Information.

Active collection of Personal Information and purpose thereof

During your visit to our website, CROSSFLIGHT may actively collect information from its visitors both by asking you specific questions and by permitting you to communicate directly with us via e-mail. Some of the information that you submit may be Personal Information.

Some areas of the website may require you to submit Personal Information in order for you to benefit from the specified features (such as e-mail alerts or information updates).

Passive collection of Personal Information and purpose thereof

As you navigate through a website, certain information can be passively collected (that is, gathered without your actively providing the information) using various technologies and means, such as Internet Protocol addresses, cookies (see next paragraph), Internet tags and navigational data collection.

This website uses Internet Protocol (IP) addresses. An IP Address is a number assigned to your computer by your Internet service provider so you can access the Internet and is generally considered to be non- personally identifiable information, because in most cases an IP address is dynamic (changing each time you connect to the Internet), rather than static (unique to a particular user's computer). We may use your IP address to diagnose problems with our server, report aggregate information, determine the fastest route for your computer to use in connecting to our site, and administer and improve the site.

Cookies

Cookies are small text files that a website can send to a user's browser for storage on the hard drive. Cookies can make use of the web easier by saving and administering status, application, preferences and other user information. Most browsers are initially set to accept cookies but users can change the setting to refuse cookies or to be alerted when cookies are being sent.

When you view our website, CROSSFLIGHT may store some information on your computer. This will be in the form of a cookie file. We use cookies to store information which we may use to improve the content of our site and to customise the site to your preferences. CROSSFLIGHT also uses cookies to gather statistics on the use of www.crossflight.com. No information is passed to CROSSFLIGHT from any [crossflight.com](http://www.crossflight.com) cookie or its use. The cookie can only be accessed by www.crossflight.com.

We consider your browser settings to reflect your consent to, or refusal of, the cookies we use on our website. If you prefer not to accept cookies or if you prefer to be warned when one is being used, you can update these settings in the settings menu of your browser. Please consult the documentation provided by the vendor of your browser if you are unsure how to do this. Note however, that if you or your site administrator has disabled cookies, the website may not function properly.

We also use third-party services (such as Google Analytics) to collect aggregate information about the visitors to our website. These third-party services use cookies to provide us with non-personally identifiable information about your visit to this website (e.g. the number visits, location from which you visited this website and the number of pages you visited on this website). We use this information to improve the presentation and content of this website. Please note

that data that is collected by these third-party services outside www.crossflight.com - if any - will not be governed by this privacy policy, but by the privacy policies of the respective third party.

In particular, e-mail sent to or from CROSSFLIGHT may not be secure, and you should therefore take special care in deciding what information you send to us via e-mail. Moreover, where you use passwords, ID numbers, or other special access features on CROSSFLIGHT's website, it is your responsibility to safeguard them.
